

Gazeta wyborcza:**Indians will build service centre in Wrocław.**

KPIT Cummins Infosystems Ltd. will open a new service centre. In three years 500 people will work there. KPIT is specialized in IT and business outsourcing. It runs activities inter alia in India, USA, Japan and Western Europe. Company representatives considered about 12 sites in Eastern Europe. But ultimately Wrocław, Łódź and Bucarest were taken into consideration.

Sanjay Mandal, President of KPIT Infosystems explains his choice: “You have highly qualified personnel. It’s close to Germany, where many of our clients come from. But the biggest asset is very dynamic development of the city”. Bhaskar Dani, development manager says: “Not only economics was taken into consideration. We feel at home here. We miss only Indian restaurant”.

New centre is to start already in June. Precise localization isn’t known yet, because KPIT is still negotiating. But it is known that initially company wants to rent about 800 m² office space and later on around 5 till 7 thousand m². “That’s the reason why in a future we may build our premises” - announces Mandal.

Centre in Wrocław will provide service for international production corporations and companies from bank and finance sector. Computer scientists employed by KPIT will produce programs for electronic parts used in cars. The other field of activity will be BPO department. Its employers will provide finance and accounting service. Till the end of the year 70 - 100 people will be recruited. But in three years KPIT is expected to employ 500 people.

Rafał Dutkiewicz, Mayor of Wrocław - “We are specially happy with this investor. It perfectly answers our expectations. We hope that Wrocław would become centre of knowledge based economy”.

Investors from a Ganges shore

500 working places will be created in Wrocław by Indian company KPIT Cummins Infosystems. It's one of the world biggest consulting companies. "We create programs for machines on production lines, for banks and other systems, for example motorization. We also take care of finance consulting for international concerns" - explains Bhaskar Dani, KPIT Cummins development manager.

In Wrocław Indians will create centre for Europe. In three years they will recruit 500 people. The first employees will be recruited in June. KPIT will be looking for highly qualified computer scientists and economists. But even 70% of personnel will be university graduates and people with one year of experience.

Service centre in Wrocław.

KPIT Cummins Infosystems, consulting company, providing services for IT sector, will launch service centre in Wrocław. In three years it will recruit 500 computer scientists and accountants skilled in European accounting systems and VAT regulations. Probably investment will be involved in Special Economic Zone and additionally KPIT will receive grants for creation of working places.

Wrocław competed with Łódź and Bucarest - says Paweł Panczyj, head of foreign investments support unit in municipality of Wrocław.
